Beaune 1er Cru "Bressandes"

Located north of Beaune at the top of the hill, our Beaune Bressandes 1er Cru benefits from sandy soil. It is one of Beaune's most refined wines.

It takes its name from Jean Bressand, a 13th-century Canon of Beaune who owned the vineyard.
