The kings of France have always served Beaune wine at their tables. Beaune Clos du Roi 1er Cru was a property of the Dukes of Burgundy, cultivated by the Beaunois who then delivered the barrels to the court of Versailles. The Sun King was a great admirer of Beaune wine, and came here on pilgrimage.

Aging: 22 months in oak barrels
