## Beaune “Les Mariages”

Located to the north of Beaune, at the bottom of the hillside, our Beaune “Les Mariages” is a village appellation benefiting from clay-limestone soil.

The name comes from the fact that the people of Beaune regularly strolled through the village at the end of the wedding banquet. It was a sort of digestive stroll where the various weddings in the area gathered.
