

DOMAINE BESANCENOT

Beaune 1er Cru "à L'Ecu"

The smallest of Beaune's climats, only 3 owners share it, and the only ones to claim the appellation.

The name "à l'Ecu" probably originates from the Middle Ages: this "clos" enabled the owners of the time to pay the royalties they owed to the Dukes of Burgundy.

Soil: clay-limestone

Area planted: 19,30 ares

Grape variety: 100% Pinot Noir

Growing methods : Reasoned - HVE 4

Ageing: 22 months in oak barrels

Corking: DIAM cork
