

DOMAINE BESANCENOT

Bourgogne Hautes côtes de Beaune

The AOC is a regional appellation of the Burgundy vineyards. The red wines have the aromatic strength of this grape variety, and are powerful yet full-bodied. Sometimes firm in their youth, they find harmony and balance after a few years. Our parcel is located on Mont Battois, at the top of the Beaune mountain range.
